

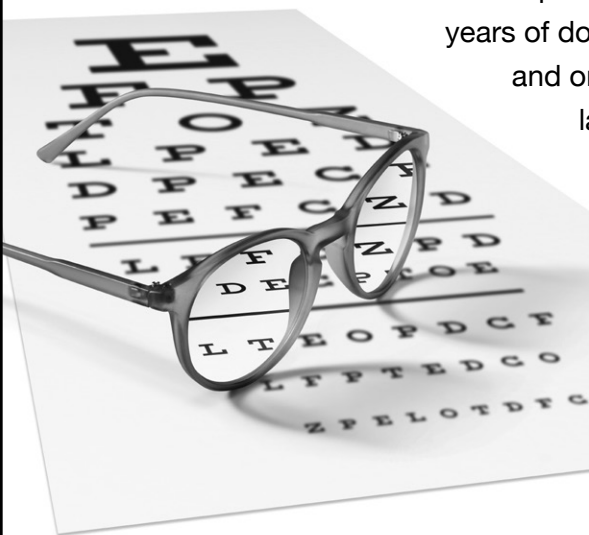
# SEE THE DIFFERENCE AT YOUR DOCTOR OF OPTOMETRY
